

# Mapping a Wicked Problem

*In this exercise, map as many facets of the complex, wicked problem as possible within the five archetypal areas below. Use post-it notes (of a corresponding color if possible). Print clearly and in a brief phrase (single words may mean something to you, but not to others) that describes a single issue—it is important to list just one issue per post-it note. After you have listed as many issues as possible within each category, next look for connections between the issues. For instance a lack of policy that might address a problem is often connected to issues in other areas such as a lack of understanding of the problem in the social sphere that means voters do not support it. Or, it could be that it is connected to a perceived expense or impact on profits in the economic/business arena. After a group discussion about the interdependencies/interrelations among issues contributing to the complex problem, begin to connect them with either markers or tape and label the nature of the connection.*

## Technology/Infrastructure

What issues in the area of technology/infrastructure (artifacts/buildings/technology) contribute to the problem or are related to it? It could also be a 'lack/absence' in this area that exacerbate the problem or helped give rise to it.

## Policy/Governance/Legal

What issues in the areas of policy, governance and laws contribute to the problem or are related to it? It could also be a 'lack/absence' in this area that exacerbate the problem or helped give rise to it.

## Social/Psychological

What issues related to 'how' and 'what' we think contribute to the problem or are related to it? It could also be what we're blind to/ignorant of that exacerbate the problem or helped give rise to it. How do group or cultural norms/traditions/expectation contribute?
